E-Learning Management Announcement

In consideration of the developing situation in Bangkok and Nakhon Pathom province, some international schools are exploring the possibility of a partial reopening beginning on June 1st, this is an announcement to inform about E-Learning Management during Coronavirus 2019 outbreak.

School closure

1. Although some international schools are exploring the possibility of a partial reopening beginning in June 1st, MUIDS will remain closed until further notice. The administration team will meet on June 2nd to discuss steps for reopening, but it is likely that there will be no change, and that the school year will finish with online learning. While there is benefit to in-person instruction, as of now the restrictions needed to bring students back would cause even more turbulence.
2. The last day of classes in Academic Year 2019-2020 will be June 18th. MUIDS will be reopening on August 3rd for Academic Year 2020-2021 as stated on the school website.

Online Assessment

1. While June 18th (and 19th) if necessary were to be set for quarter exams, based on the feedback from teachers who have given assessments online this year, it is impossible to have the same measures of test security that insure a fair and accurate assessment. Therefore, departments are developing alternative assessments to be given during class. The form of these assessments will vary by department, and are being developed collaboratively in grade-level teams.
2. There will be no quarter exams.
