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Admission Information announcement on the admission to Grade 10
for the academic year 2025 - 2026

To ensure that the admission process of the academic year 2025 - 2026 is implemented effectively, the Mahidol University Board of Governance adopted the Mahidol University's Ordinance 24 (5) as a regulation for selecting the applicant to study in grade 10 of the academic year 2025 - 2026, and hereby declared details of the application, selection, and other processes of the third round as follows:

Applicants' Qualifications

Applicants who are studying in a school or institution in Thailand

- Currently studying in Mathayom Suksa 3 or have finished Mathayom Suksa 3 (Thai education system) or
- Currently studying in Grade 9 or have finished Grade 9 (American education system) or
- Currently studying in Year 10 or have finished Year 10 (UK education system)

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Applicants who are studying in a school or institution overseas

- Currently studying in Grade 9 or have completed Grade 9 studies (according to the American education system) or
- Currently studying in Year 10 or have completed Year 10 studies (according to the British education system) or
- Currently studying or have completed studies that are equivalent to Mathayom Suksa 3 of the Thai education system, according to any other education system

Remark:

1. Applicants must be physically healthy, without any diseases or conditions that might inhibit their ability to study. Applicants must be willing to follow the school's current regulations, or any future changes.
2. The school does not allow applicants who do not meet the eligibility criteria to take the entrance exam in all circumstances.

Application Process and Required Documents

All applicants must fill out an online application form, available on the website <https://muidsadmission.mahidol.ac.th> If the applicant provides any false or misleading information in the online application system, the school will terminate the application immediately, and the applicant will no longer be eligible for examinations. Documents required for application are as follows:

Applicants who are studying in a school or institution in Thailand

1. A file of the applicant's photo (Front view, in school uniform / formal attire) which should be taken not more than 6 months prior to the application.
2. A photocopy of the applicant's identification card
3. A photocopy of the applicant's house registration (the first page of the house registration and the page containing the applicant's name)

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4. A photocopy of the applicant's report card or transcript
 - Mathayom Suksa 1 – 2 report card or transcript (Thai education system)
or
 - Grade 7 – 8 report card or transcript (American education system) or
 - Year 8 – 9 report card or transcript (UK education system)
5. A photocopy of the certificate of student status as a student who is currently in Mathayom Suksa 3 / Grade 9 / Year 10 from the applicant's current school (the certificate should be no more than 120 days old)
6. If the applicant has already finished middle school (Mathayom Suksa 3), the certificate of education status (๑พ.2) and transcript (๑พ.1) could be used for application.

Applicants who are studying in a school or institution overseas

1. A file of the applicant's photo (Front view, in school uniform / formal attire) which should be taken not more than 6 months prior to the application.
2. A photocopy of the applicant's identification card or passport (for overseas applicants only).
3. A photocopy of the applicant's house registration (the first page of the house registration and the page containing the applicant's name).
4. A photocopy of the applicant's academic transcript
 - Grade 7 – 8 academic transcript (American education system) or
 - Year 8 – 9 academic transcript (British education system) or
 - An academic transcript of any other education system, which is equivalent to Mathayom Suksa 1 – 2 of the Thai education system
5. A certificate of student status for Grade 9 / Year 10 / Any other education system that is equivalent to Mathayom Suksa 3 of the Thai education system (the certificate must not be more than 120 days old)
6. A photocopy of the course syllabus for credit transfer consideration (if necessary).

Remark:

1. Application documents must be in Thai or English only.
2. Applicants who are currently studying overseas must be approved by the credit transfer committee of the school for their eligibility of taking the entrance exam, and will be considered based on their application documents. Applicants will be notified of their credit transfer results within 1 – 7 working days after completely submitting all application documents.

Application Fee Payment

Applicants must pay an application fee of 5,000 baht. The application fee payment slip could be printed by logging in at <https://muidsadmission.mahidol.ac.th> and choose “Print application fee payment slip”. The application fee could be paid at Siam Commercial Bank (SCB) or via mobile banking application. The application fee must be paid within the last day of application for each application round. If the application fee is paid for a particular application round, the applicant must take examinations in the same round, otherwise the applicant’s examination will be considered as forfeited and cannot be taken in a different round. **MUIDS shall not refund the application fee in any case.**

Check Application Status

Applicants could check their application status by logging in on the website <https://muidsadmission.mahidol.ac.th> and choose “Application Fee Status” and “Application Document Status” with the following details:

1. If the “Application Fee Status” says “Completed”, this means that the application fee payment is complete.
2. If the “Application Document Status” says “Completed”, this means that all application documents have been completely uploaded.

If any of these two topics do not say “Completed” then the applicants will not be able to print out their examination card, and are not eligible for examinations in all cases.

If the application documents are incomplete, the applicant must submit these documents to the Admissions Office via email muidsadmission@mahidol.edu at least 3 days before the examination date. **If the applicant fails to submit documents in the specified time, the applicant will not be eligible for examinations in all cases.**

Admission Exams

The applicant must take all the examinations on the specified date and time that the school has provided. The score test from other institutions is not allowed to submit for consideration. If the applicant is not able to take all the examinations in the specified period, the exam will be incomplete and not accepted status.

Announcement of Eligible Candidates for Admission

After the admissions process, applicants could check the announcement of eligible candidates for admission on the website <https://muidsadmission.mahidol.ac.th> by logging in and choosing “Announcement of Eligible Candidates for Admission”. **The MUIDS Admissions Committee’s judgment is final.**

Admission Fee Payment

Selected candidates are required to pay the admission fee by printing out the admission fee payment slip on <https://muidsadmission.mahidol.ac.th> by logging in, filling out personal information in Thai, and choosing the topic “Print admission fee payment slip”. The admission fee could be paid at Siam Commercial Bank (SCB) or via online mobile banking application, within the school’s specified time. **If the applicant fails to pay their admission fee in the specified time, it shall be considered that they forfeit their admission.**

Reporting as a New Student

After the admission fee has been paid, the student and parents should receive a confirmation e-mail with announcement of activities, such as reporting as a new student, and procedures in choosing elective subjects. When reporting as a new student (the school will announce the date again), the student must submit the following documents:

Students who are studying in a school or institution in Thailand

1. Official Transcript ๒พ.1 (Original document and photocopy)
2. Certificate of Education Status ๒พ.2 (Original document and photocopy)

Students who are studying in a school or institution overseas

1. The student's academic transcript (Original document and photocopy)
 - Grade 7 – 9 academic transcript (American education system) or
 - Year 8 – 10 academic transcript (British education system) or
 - An academic transcript of any other education system, which is equivalent to Mathayom Suksa 1 – 3 of the Thai education system
2. A certificate of completion for Grade 9 / Year 10 / Any other education system that is equivalent to Mathayom Suksa 3 of the Thai education system (Original document and photocopy)


Documents No. 1 and 2 must be submitted to the registrar staff to certify that the student has completed middle school studies, within the same date as reporting of new students. Otherwise, the student will be considered as an ineligible candidate, and will not be able to commence their Mathayom Suksa 4 (Grade 10) studies at Mahidol University International Demonstration School.

If the school finds out later that the student submitted false or misleading documents during their application or reporting, the school will terminate the student's application and the student will not be able to commence their Mathayom 4 (Grade 10) studies

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Mahidol University International Demonstration School reserves the right to cancel, postpone, change the examination or any other matter in the admission process without prior notice.
