The Instruction for	Travelling	Out of T	hailand	during	COVID-19	Pandemic

Regarding the COVID-19's outbreak, the World Health Organization (WHO) officially announced that it was Public Health Emergency of the International Concern; PHEIC). Numbers of COVID-19 cases increased rapidly in many countries.

In order to protect and avoid the impact of COVID-19's outbreak, and by the Virtue of Mahidol University, Clause No. 24 (5) regarding the School Management B.E. 2556, Mahidol University International Demonstration School, (MUIDS), announces the Instruction for Travelling Out of Thailand during COVID-19 Pandemic as follows:

- 1. All rules and regulations of leaves including the travelling out of Thailand during a dayoff or holidays are cancelled temporarily. All MUIDS staff are required to follow all instructions in this announcement.
- 2. It is **NOT** allowed for all MUIDS staff to apply their leaves for travelling out of Thailand during a day-off or holidays, including traveling to the high risk countries according to the announcement from the Department of Disease Control, Ministry of Public Health until there is further announcement from the Department of Disease Control, Ministry of Public Health, Mahidol University, or School Director.
- 3. All MUIDS staff are required to follow this instruction strictly. Whoever violates this instruction will be seriously taken under the disciplinary action (depending on some cases). If the medical test result shows and confirms that there is infection (genetic material of the novel coronavirus detected, COVID-19), he/she will be seriously taken under the disciplinary action according to this announcement and will also be responsible for legal liability regarding this matter.

Henceforth, with the effective date as of February 28, 2020.
