Development Hours, Community Service Hours & ePortfolio Internship Placements **During Covid-19** 

Due to the ongoing Covid-19 situation in Thailand and the world, MUIDS is setting a policy for Development Hours, Community Service Hours, and ePortfolio Internship Placements for the 2020-21 school year. No Development Hours, Community Service Hours, or ePortfolio Internship Placements that violate these guidelines will be accepted as meeting the requirements for graduation.

- Any Development Hours, Community Service Hours and & ePortfolio Internship Placements that take place in a business must follow the health practices as laid out by the Thai Ministry of Public Health, including the wearing of personal protective equipment (PPE) by all employees (including the student) and following social distancing guidelines.
  - Students taking part in these Development Hours, Community Service Hours and ePortfolio Internship Placement sites must sign the agreement on the back of this policy indicating that they will adhere to these requirements.
  - If a student tests positive for Covid-19, they agree to remove themselves from the school until they are able to present a negative Covid-19 result, with the understanding that this may put them past the 20% absence mark set by the Ministry of Education.
- Any Development Hours, Community Service Hours and ePortfolio Internship Placements at hospitals are not allowed at this time. If the situation improves, and the Ministry of Public Health changes its guidelines with this improvement, students will be eligible to join Development Hours and ePortfolio Internship Placements no earlier than the April Songkran holiday. As of now, this is not guaranteed.
